Points Discussed:

- 1. The discussion on the peer team report was carried out in detail.
- Through mutual consent it was agreed upon to include MOOC courses as assignments in the subject. Also, faculties are supposed to look for MOOC courses which lead to certification.
- 3. To improve the placement, more emphasis will be laid upon training of the students from the third year of engineering. The details to be decided by training and placement cell and plan to be submitted to IQAC and a calendar to be prepared for the same.
- 4. The departments are to plan the various guest lectures, workshops and competitions and place it through IQAC for approval.
- The department of electronics and telecommunication engineering needs to start preparation for applying to NBA accreditation with 2019-20 as the current academic year.
- 6. In line with outcome-based education, all courses should have 6 course outcomes, with a mapping of one CO to one module. The statements of the COs may be modified, as per the discretion of the subject teacher with explanation.
- 7. With respect to the internal assessment examinations, I and II, before IAI, 3 modules should be covered and questions should be based on three Cos as per the weightage converted from hours to marks. Same to be implemented for IAII.
- The MOU with NGO representative Mrs Rashmi Joshi, environmental consultant to be renewed.
- Initialization and set-up of Human Value cell to be done in the campus. Dr. Shelley Oberoi as the coordinator for it.
- 10. Asst Prof Rajiv Iyer to look into the set-up of E-Yantra lab, a MHRD initiative in association with IIT Bombay, as a part of the sponsored lab.

- 11. 2nd surveillance audit for ISO will be tentatively scheduled in the month of September after the admission process. So, information to be disbursed to all departments and sections for the preparation of the same.
- 12. Once the advertisement is released from the University of Mumbai, faculties are supposed to apply under the scheme. A minimum of three minor research proposal can be submitted by each of the departments. The overall successful completion of the application process to be taken care by Dr. Baban Rindhe.
